

Class Pass Options

Class Pass Individual- \$5000 (potential \$15,000+ value)

- Includes UNLIMITED registration to ANY regular scheduled class, custom and certified classes for one year
- Non-Transferable
- Books NOT Included
- Certification Exams NOT Included
- Year begins on the first day class taken

Class Pass Corporate- \$9000 (potential \$30,000+ value)

- Includes UNLIMITED registration to ANY regular scheduled class, custom and certified classes for one year
- Transferable (any two employees can take any class the same day)
- Books NOT Included
- Certification Exams NOT Included
- Year begins on the first day of class taken by an employee

Questions & Answers:

Question One: *How is the potential saving calculated?*

Answer: We are open approximately 180 days a year. If the student came to class each day at the lowest price of \$85, that would be the estimate of $180 \times \$85 = \$15,000$. A more practical example would be, if a student enrolled for the Microsoft Certified IT Professional Program the cost would be \$5,000 and then took some application courses and a few Web Design classes. The value would be well over \$7,500.

Question Two: *I'm confused on how Class Pass for a company works?*

Answer: After the \$9,000 is paid, the company or agency can send two employees to class per day. You could have one employee in Word while the other employee takes Networking.

Question Three: *I have an individual Class Pass, can I let someone else use it?*

Answer: No, Individual Class Pass can't be transferred to use by someone else.

Question Four: *Who pays for your books?*

Answer: The individual or company is responsible for paying for book and or reference material. Computer Tutors can invoice you for book. Payment is due by 30 days from class taken.

Question Five: *How do you register?*

Answer: To register for class you will need to fill out the enrollment form. All attendees must fill out enrollment form prior to class.

Questions Six: *How many people are in a department?*

Answer: A department generally is 15 to 20 people.
